PITA Announces 2010 All Star Team Selections

Following the end of the 2010 target year, the PITA announced shooters selected to the All Star team based on averages over all events all year. Gig Harbor shooter Grant Lau was selected as one of the 15 members of the Men's All Star team for 2010. Grant was the only shooter from Washington to make the Men's Team, which was dominated by members from California and Oregon.
